4) **The Practice:**

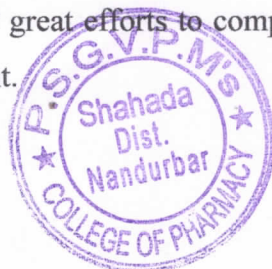
