GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

P.S.G.V.P.Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Shahada is committed to create environmentconsciousness among its members and in the society. Environment friendly practices areencouraged for sustainable development and the institution set in harmony with nature promotes a stress-free learning environment on the campus. The green practices adopted by theinstitution are discussed hereunder. Rain water recycling and harvest rain water to resolve and manage water scarcity problemsthat may arise in the future. Our maintenance staff regularly inspects tap leakages and attends to repair needs immediately to avoid loss of potable water. The use of water is minimized inhostels by facilitating the use of washing machines.

Water Resources and Rain Water Harvesting

As the college is located in a hot climatic zone, the college realizes the importance of conservation and the best utilization of water resources. The college maintains and generateswater resources. The college has a bore well to meet the general needs of the institution. Theinstitution encourages recycling of RO water and rain water harvesting. The water from the roof tops along with the rain water is collected through a well-connectedpipe work delivery system. This arrangement is helpful in collecting water, which is thencollected into pits, specially constructed for this purpose. The rain water stored in the pits, isused for the maintenance of the green cover on the campus. In the hot summer season, whenwater scarcity is more, the surrounding bore wells get recharged and the ground water levelincreases.

Energy Consumption

LED bulbs are used in maximum to save energy. Electric and electronic equipment isturned off when not in use.

Restricted Entry of Automobiles

No vehicle is allowed into the campus, making the campus pollution free. The vehicles are parked outside the gate of the campus. Students nearby are encouraged to come by bicycles tocollege. The college are Separate Girls Vehicle Parking

Pedestrian-friendly Paths

The pathways inside the campus are well maintained and pedestrians can walk safely throughthe campus as entry of vehicles is restricted. Security Guards at the gates keep a watch onthe entry of vehicles and crossing into the campus. Pedestrian friendly pathways are properlymarked with suitable sign boards. Many of the nonteaching staff and a few students in andaround the location daily walk down to college.
